



Tara Stopfel Warden, PhD (2020) serves as the Assistant Vice Provost for Advising & Academic Services at the University of Cincinnati (UC.) She specializes in strategic leadership practice and program design for advising, enrollment management, and student success. Tara has established programs recognized regionally and nationally for innovation or exemplary practice. She provides leadership to the university's 18 advising centers on three campuses and is responsible for orientation, college credit services, transfer advising, pre-professional advising, and advising technologies.
